**2022 Summer Teacher**

The Summer Teacher is responsible for providing engaging and challenging experiential learning activities to a cohort of up to 20 elementary or middle school youth over a five-week period in June and early-July 2022. EBAYC Summer Learning programs will be held at La Escuelita Elementary School, Garfield Elementary School, Manzanita SEED, Roosevelt Middle School, Edna Brewer Middle School, and Frick United Academy of Language. EBAYC is hiring 38 Summer Teachers.

**Core Responsibilities**

1. Participate in all 2022 EBAYC Summer Teacher Orientation Week sessions and activities.
2. Prepare all daily lesson plans and activities.
3. Instruct, coach, supervise, and support a learning cohort of up to 20 elementary or middle school youth for five weeks, Monday through Friday, from 12:30pm to 5:30pm.
4. Participate in all Summer Teacher Team daily program debriefs.

**Minimum Qualifications**

1. One year professional experience providing after-school instruction to elementary or middle school youth.
2. Knowledge of and competence in the development of project-based learning themes, lessons, and activities.
3. Knowledge of and competence in the development of Building Intentional Communities lessons and activities.
